

Carbon Policy

Speller Metcalfe acknowledges that its activities have a major impact on the environment on a local, regional and global scale and will minimise any harmful effects by adopting a responsible attitude to related issues.

We also recognise that sustainable development rests not only on environmental matters but the combination of three key pillars, the economy, society and the environment. As such we aim to address our impacts and commitment to managing these impacts within this policy.

We will at least meet, and where practicable exceed, all relevant legislation and regulations and aim to continually improve our environmental performance as well as the contribution to society and the economy that our projects can bring.

In order to reduce the Monitoring the carbon footprint of our operations on an annual basis with the aim of continual reduction in relation to the net value of works carried out. In the long term we recognise the National targets set in the UK Climate Change Act 2008 to reduce the UK's carbon footprint by 50% in 2050 and commit to play our part in this.

Climate Change is defined as the change in the state of global climate patterns, which is attributed largely to an increase of levels of atmospheric carbon dioxide produced by the use of fossil fuels. Climate change may be due to natural internal processes or external factors, but a marked increase in extreme weather conditions can be seen following the increase in fossil fuel use during the industrial revolution.

As such, proactive management and reduction of sources of greenhouse gases have become a cornerstone of our company Sustainability Strategy.

To achieve our policy, we will focus on 5 key elements of working:

1. Monitoring of Carbon emissions resulting from employee business travel.
2. Monitoring of Carbon emissions resulting from commercial vehicles.
3. Monitoring of Carbon emissions resulting from plant fuel.
4. Monitoring of Carbon emissions resulting from our offices, and
5. Working with our clients and supply chain on reducing their energy use and emissions.

Our policy will be delivered by measuring all scope one and scope two emissions:

Scope one emissions are comprised from the direct emissions from each of our construction sites such as the impact from our vehicle fleet, gas and fuel consumption.

Scope two emissions are the indirect emissions such as electricity from the national grid which supplies all of our site cabins and permanent offices.

Once these measurements have been taken and collated, annual Carbon production benchmarks can be produced based upon our annual turnover, to actively reduce our yearly company Carbon footprint by 5%.


This policy will take immediate effect and will be renewed and amended as necessary.
